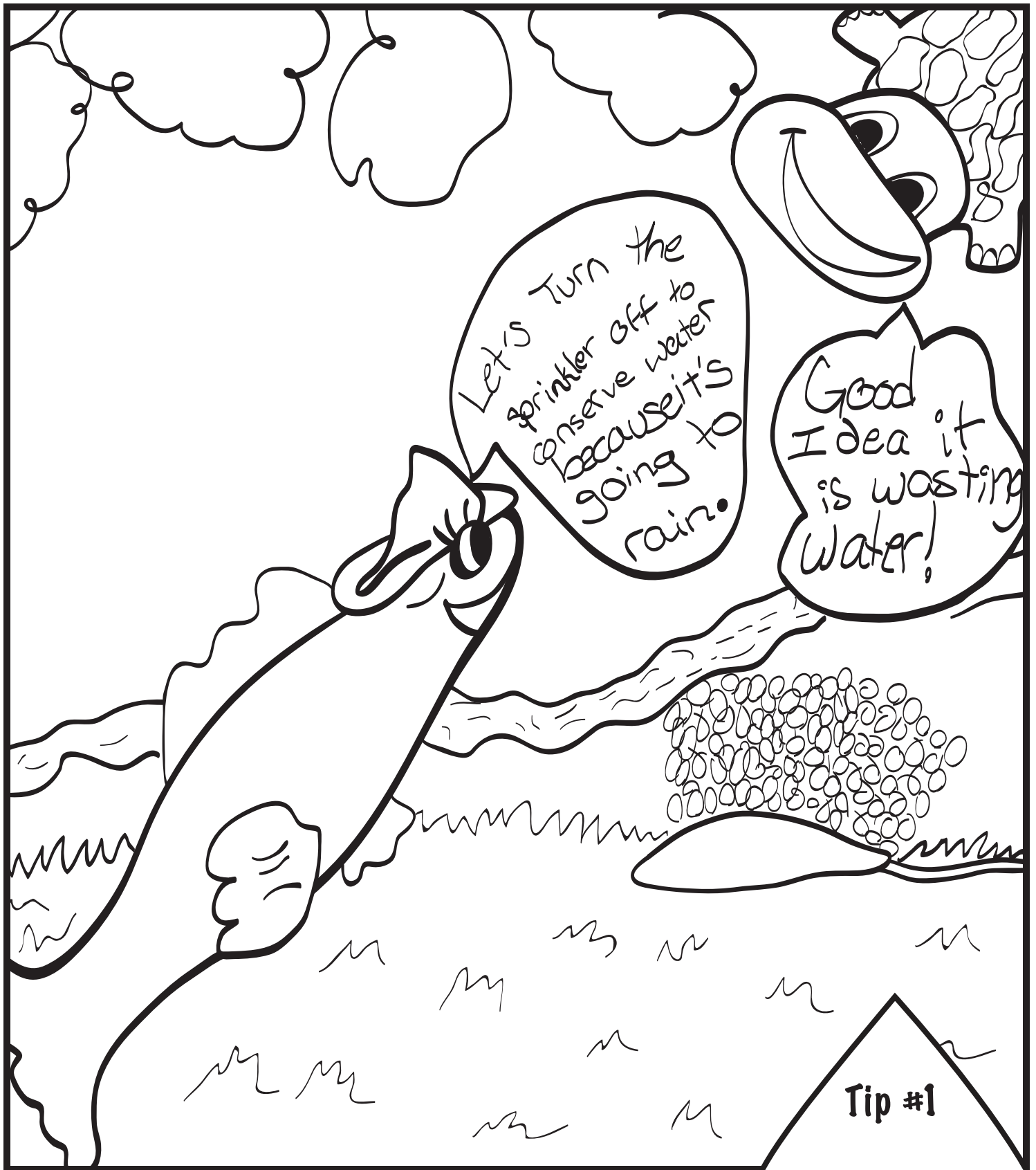

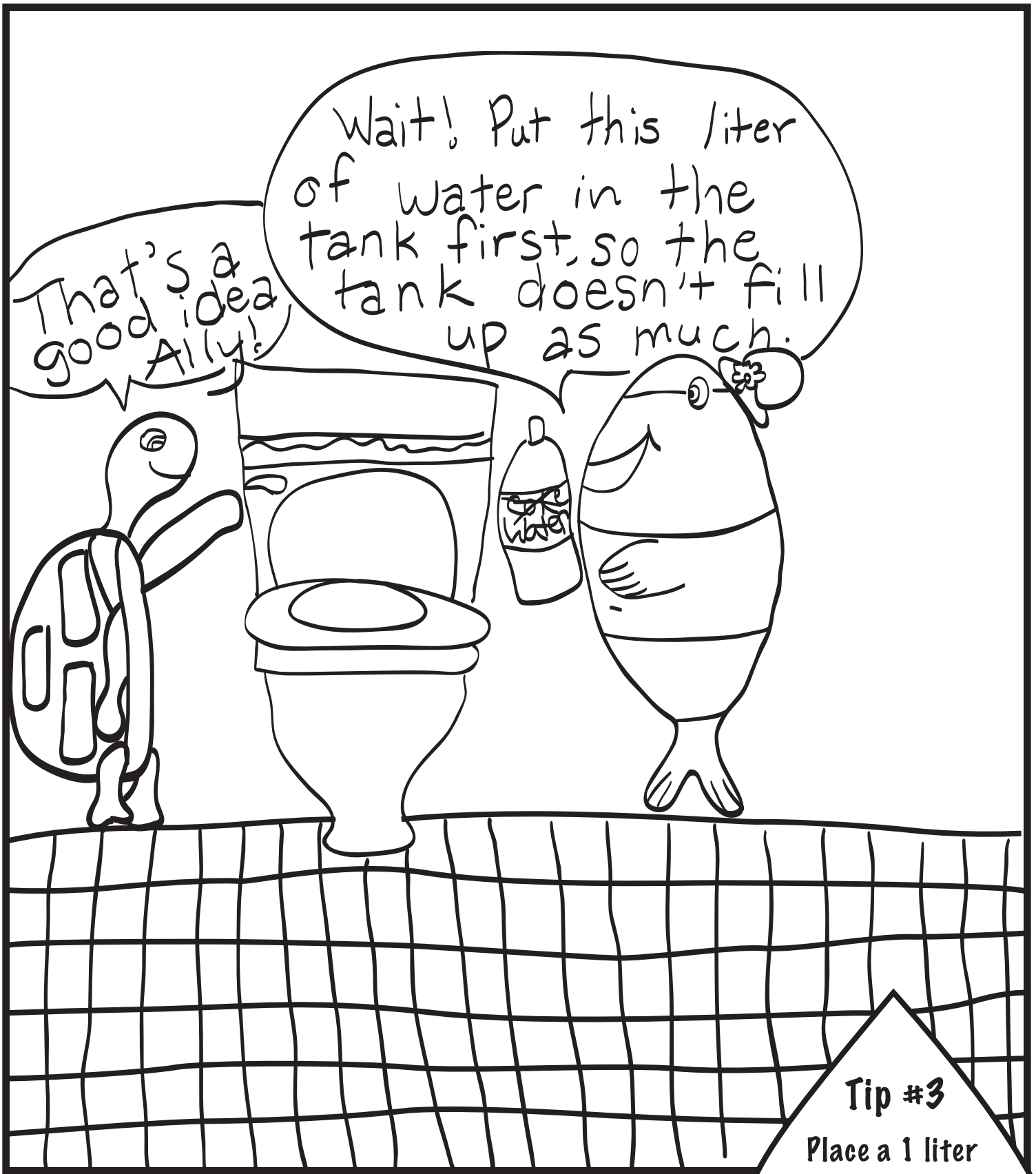
Turn off sprinklers
